

Elizabethtown Boys Club Board Meeting 8/13/08

Previous Meeting Minutes Reviewed: The meeting minutes from the July 9, 2008 meeting were reviewed and the motion to accept the minutes was first and seconded.

Treasurer's Report: The Treasurer's Report was read and the motion to accept the report was first and seconded.

GEARS/Poplar Street Report: Spencer went to the Elizabethtown Borough Meeting on behalf of the EBC. Spencer voiced the displeasure, of the EBC, about the Borough proposing to mandate a road to be built through three multipurpose fields across from Foxianna Road. One of those fields has been designated to the EBC for use during the football season as a practice field and a JV field. Spencer is also hoping to work with the Elizabethtown Park Authority and Masonic to build baseball fields along Bainbridge Road. Screens are needed in the concessions stand. Spencer asked the board to allow him and his company, Heisey Construction, to build the screens "at cost." The board unanimously approved the motion.

Cheerleading: Cheerleading is progressing well. Problems are seen with the A Squad where parents are not interested in paying for Crop Tops, Bloomers and sneakers in addition to the registration costs. Cheerleading is also selling overstock t-shirts from the previous seasons and competitions. Registrations are a little above average compared to previous years.

Baseball: There is a baseball meeting scheduled on 8/20/08 concerning the future of EBC Baseball. Middletown and Maytown has expressed interest in joining to form a league. Fall Ball was cancelled this year.

Wrestling: No Report

Football: Both scales are fixed and certified. Coach Polites is allowing us to house on of the scales at Thompson Field. Schedule for the Red Rose League should be finalized by 8/14/08.

Fundraising: Football fundraisers went out this week. Hats and visors are for sale in the concessions stand at Poplar Street. At the first home game, we are going to buy 250 pretzels as discussed at the last meeting (7/9/08).

Website/Media Update: Keep the updates coming. July saw 537 visitors while August has seen 275 to date. Overall we have seen 8,140 visitors for the 2007-2008 year. Since the website's redesign in August 2006, we have seen a total of 12,825 visitors.

Unfinished Business: Mike said to not worry about fixing the copier in the Equipment Shed office due to the current conditions of the shed. Spencer will fill out the Building Permit for the construction of the batting cage.

New Business: John Fosnot asked the board for approval for a \$100 donation to the Bainbridge Believers. The Bainbridge Believers supports cancer research. The board unanimously approved the motion.
