President's Meeting Message: It's all about the kids! And, Bowl-A-Rama too!

Previous Meeting Minutes Reviewed: November 9, 2011 meeting minutes were read & accepted by motion.

Treasurer's Report: November 2011 report was read & accepted by passed motion.

GEARS/Facilities/High School: 1) On November 26, someone broke into our shed. They also broke the screen door in the concession stand. As far as we know, nothing else was broken or missing. We had to replace the latches and locks and will replace the screen door in the Spring. 2) The water is now shut off at the concession stand. It will not be turned on until April. So, no one should use the restrooms. 3) If anyone needs to use our van, please contact John.

Athletic Director Report: 1) The equipment needs to be moved up to the 2nd level in the storage area because of all of the roofing leaks. We'll need to build shelves to house the equipment.

Cheerleading: 1) We had a great year. The competition went extremely well. Thank you to all our volunteers, parents and girls! 2) We want to add a Tumbling Class to the Cheerleading program. This will help us do better at competitions. We will start the program early next year. 3) We handed out the Bowl-A-Rama sheets at the uniform turn in. We are only missing four uniforms. Sharon will follow-up with the girls' parents.

Baseball: no report

Wrestling: 1) We are just beginning our season and have 67 registrations. We've been practicing for two weeks and the tournaments are coming up soon. 2) Last year we had regular wrestling and our competition team consisted of 15 kids. We offer each kid two free tournaments. The free tournaments must be the \$10 tournaments. 3) The dual tournaments cost a lot more, hundreds of dollars. A motion was made to pay for 2 or 3 dual meet tournaments from the Boys Club treasury. The motion was seconded & passed by vote.

Football: 1) The Quarterback Club dates are now set for January, February and March. 2) Right now, we have to continue as we are currently structured because of the number of coaches we have. We also do not know of there will be a High School 7th or 8th grade team. There are other factors to also consider. 3) A motion was made to approve the new pricing structure. The motion was seconded and passed by vote. The new pricing is \$65 for A, B, C, & D squads and goes down to \$45 for each additional child in that program. Pee Wee Football is \$25 per child.

Fundraising: 1) Bowl-A-Rama is Sunday, January 29, 2012. Flyers were handed out to every football player at the roller skating rink party and to all but four cheerleaders. We need at least twenty-five teams at \$250 per team. We need to get with the coaches and nail down the number of teams in early January. Team and sponsor sheets are on our website.

Website/Media Update: 1) Activity Report: November saw 3,379 visitors. Our month-to-date visitor count is 1,509. Year-to-date visitor count is 43,835. Football, cheerleading & wrestling are driving these numbers.

Unfinished Business: 1) The Rotary Project is on hold. 2) The ice machine is fixed and up to code.

New Business: 1) Scott Gregory was nominated as Vice President #1. The vote approved Scott into this position. Welcome aboard! 2) We need to encourage volunteers to fill all the open Board positions.
