GEARS/Facilities/High School: 1) We emailed GEARS requesting facility meeting dates for February. 2) Backstop approval needs to be gained this month to get the fields ready in plenty of time for Baseball's opening day of April 4.

Baseball: 1) Last walk-in sign-ups are this week and the numbers are close to last year. Late fees will be imposed next year. 2) We're installing a new batting cage net (nylon is more weather resistant). 3) Coaches are all set plus we have some in waiting. 4) We're working on sponsors. We have new sponsors because we have more teams. 5) We need to have a meeting about the Concession Stand. 6) We're working on help for the fields. 7) We're looking at a Coaches clinic. 8) Baseball Camp is scheduled for Tuesday June 28th through Thursday June 30th, from 9:00 AM until 12 Noon. We're sending the information out to other clubs and would like to get at least 100 kids.

Wrestling: 1) We're up to 242 registrations for the Novice Tournament scheduled for February 19th. The Refreshment Stand is set. We need help on Friday night at 6:00 PM to set-up and also need help during the tournament from 8:00 AM until 3:00 PM.

Fundraising: 1) Wrestling Fundraiser – goal is 10 subs per wrestler. 2) We need to pick dates for Baseball. 3) Bowl-A-Rama: We're waiting on a few checks and projecting a \$12,000 profit.

Website/Media Update: 1) Activity Report - January saw 429 visitors. February to-date saw 109 visitors. Our YTD visitor count is 3,049 since August 19, 2010. Baseball sign-up is driving these numbers. 2) New Website: a) The first & second designs are approved. b) We will have logon information soon for adding content & loading. c) Training & "how-to" videos are provided online. If needed, we will work on training.

Unfinished Business: 1) Baseball Concession Stand meeting will be Wednesday or Thursday of next week. 2) The old van was sold. We will store the new van elsewhere due to the continual vandalism issues in the GEAR's alley. 3) The installation of the new Concession Stand ceiling is scheduled for March 1st.

New Business: 1) We discussed registration fees versus current costs. Registration income accounts for approximately 17 - 20% of our costs. We need to make changes. 2) Suggestion for Bowl-A-Rama: Call it the "Annual Bowling Party" and sell tickets all year at \$35.00 per bowler.
